#### SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Dayshift was steady all day with calls for service. We investigated a domestic violence call where a male assaulted the mother of his child, threatened to kill her and held her against her will. She was able to escape and come to the police department to report the incident. We located the suspect at his home and he was arrested. He was booked for felony assault, kidnapping, false imprisonment, and criminal threats. An Emergency Protective Order was sought and granted by a judge for the victim. We also investigated an elder abuse call where a male assaulted his elderly mother during an argument. He was arrested and booked for elder abuse and an Emergency Protective Order was sought and granted for this victim also. A male was contacted downtown and cited for a warrant. A female was contacted during a trespassing call and also cited for a warrant. This afternoon, we handled an injury accident where a pedestrian was hit by a vehicle.
