Allied agencies were contacted to see if firearm

found might have been used in an incident in their jurisdiction. With no matches, the firearm was placed into TPD property. Officers spent some time in a northern retail area and made traffic enforcement stops on several vehicles that were congregating in a parking lot. One of the stops resulted in a driver being arrested for DWI.

SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

An officer made a bicycle stop for a vehicle code violation. The bicyclist was on probation and found to be in possession of fentanyl. He was arrested and booked in jail. An officer also made a traffic stop and contacted a female driver. She was showing signs of intoxication and failed her field sobriety tests. She was arrested for DUI. Late in the shift officers responded to a death-unknown call. The victim was a 20-year-old female who was found deceased in her bed by her husband. The body appeared to have bruises and scratches, and dried blood was on the bed and pillows. Due to the suspicious circumstances, detectives were notified and responded to take over the investigation. At the time of this log the incident was still being investigated.
