#### AMENDMENT TO CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 1989-36 (TURLOCK COVENANT CHURCH) The Turlock Covenant Church is proposing to amend their existing Conditional Use Permit to allow a K-12 private school to operate on the second floor of the Education Building. The total school enrollment will be no more than 140 students. Typical school hours would be 8:00 am – 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. The project is located at 260 High Street, more specifically described as Stanislaus County Assessor's Parcel No. 050-024-027. View Item

There is a \$125.00 filing fee for the Appeal Application. If an Appeal Application is filed, a Public Hearing will be scheduled by the City Council to consider the appeal.

The request must be written and filed with the City of Turlock Planning Division.
